## Tournament Preview

Gettysburg will seek its 10th Days Inn Tip-Off Tournament title as it welcomes Elizabethtown College, SUNY Geneseo, and Rowan University to the 18th annual event.

The Bullets are the defending tournament champions and have captured two of the last three and five of the last seven titles.

This year's tournament promises to be highly competitive, as it includes four teams that all finished with a winning record in 2007-08. The tournament will feature schools from four different conferences (Centennial, Commonwealth, NJAC, SUNYAC), and two of the three visiting teams have been here before. Geneseo

played in the 2003 tournament and lost 72-55 to Muskingum in the first round before defeating Delaware Valley 66-52 in the consolation game. Elizabethtown made its only appearance in 1994 and topped Colby 84-79 in the first round before losing to Gettysburg in the championship game, 73-71.

Rowan is making its debut appearance in the Days Inn Tournament.

## 2007 Tournament Recap

Tournament MVP **Dan Capkin** scored a career-high 31 points on sizzling 13-of-17 shooting and Gettysburg rallied from a nine-point half-time deficit to defeat Messiah College 81-67 in the championship game of the 17th annual Gettysburg Days Inn Tip-Off Tournament.

After trailing for most of the first half, Gettysburg used a pair of runs to first retake the lead, then pull away at the end. Messiah led 54-47 with 14:28 left before the Bullets went in front to stay after a 13-0 run.

Capkin finished with 58 points for the tournament after a 27-point night in the Bullets' first-round win over Marietta.

Messiah kicked off the tournament with a 73-63 victory over Wesley. Four Falcons scored in double figures, led by **Josh Curtin's** 14. **Rashawn**

**Johnson** paced Wesley with 20 points.

In the other first-round game, Gettysburg topped Marietta 89-82, which included a 22-point effort from **Andrew Powers** in his collegiate debut.

Wesley topped Marietta 101-87 in an entertaining consolation game that featured 71 three-point attempts. Johnson poured in 30 points on 7-of-14 three-point shooting for Wesley while **Isaiah Creasap** notched 23 points and canned 7-of-12 treys for Marietta.

Powers was named to the all-tournament team along with **Andy Hawk** and Curtin from Messiah, Johnson from Wesley and Creasap from Marietta.

## SCOUTING REPORT

### ELIZABETHTOWN COLLEGE BLUE JAYS

The Blue Jays are off to a 2-0 start following their 73-62 come-from-behind victory over Lancaster Bible on Tuesday. Elizabethtown trailed by as much as 13 in the first half before cutting the deficit to five at the half. The Blue Jays then outscored the Chargers 48-32 in the second half. Etown also captured its season opener, topping Alvernia College 68-63. Sophomore **Joe Flanagan** leads the team in scoring with 15.0 points per game while junior center **Mike Church** has added 14.0 points per game and a team-leading 10.5 rebounds per night. Sophomore guard **Keith Fogel** has contributed 10.2 points per game while senior guard **Phil Schaffer** (right) has distributed 13 assists and made seven steals. Last season, Elizabethtown finished 15-9 and 2-8 in the Commonwealth Conference. After starting the season 13-1, the Jays lost eight of their final 10 games. The team lost its top two scorers from a year ago but Church is back after posting 11.7 points and a team-leading 5.9 rebounds per game in 2007-08.



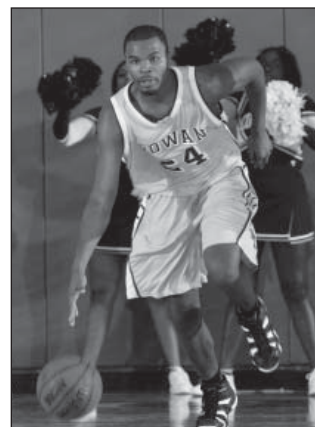
### GETTYSBURG COLLEGE BULLETS

The Bullets are the only team in the this year's tournament field that has not played a game this year. Gettysburg is coming off a record-setting 2007-08 season in which it finished 24-5, winning four more games than any team in school history. The Bullets also went 16-2 in conference play and reached the Centennial Conference championship game before posting their first two NCAA playoff victories in team history en route to their march to the Sweet 16. All five starters return from last year's squad, including senior guard **Dan Capkin**, who led the team in scoring with 19.6 points per game. Senior **Corey Dorsey** (16.1 ppg) joins Capkin in the backcourt, as does senior point guard **Chris Nevolo**. Sophomore center **Andrew Powers** is back after posting 14.9 points and 7.9 rebounds per game while senior forward **Joe Spierenburg** (right) added 10.2 points and 7.4 rebounds per game while resetting his own school record for blocked shots with 112 swats, a mark that ranked second in Division III.



### ROWAN UNIVERSITY PROFS

Rowan carries an 0-2 record into the tournament after dropping a 67-61 decision to Immaculata on Tuesday. In their season opener on Saturday, the Profs were edged by Arcadia in triple overtime, 94-90. Senior guard **Kevin Darby** (right), who scored 31 points against Arcadia, leads the team with 24.0 points per game while junior forward **Tyson Hartnett** has posted 13.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per outing. Senior guard **Dan Reddan** and junior guard **Allen Pritchett** have tossed in 9.5 and 8.0 points per game, respectively. Rowan is coming off an 18-8 season in which it finished 7-6 in the New Jersey Athletic Conference (NJAC). The Profs lost 83-72 to Montclair State in the first round of the NJAC Tournament. The team is without three of its top four scorers from a year ago, but Darby was second among the Profs in scoring with 13.1 points per game last season. Senior guard **Aaron Spellman** also returns after posting 6.7 points per game.



### SUNY GENESEO BLUE KNIGHTS

The Knights are 1-0 after opening their season on Saturday with a 76-53 win over Elmira. Senior forward **Jeff Howe** led the Blue Knights with an outstanding game, scoring 27 points on 12-of-15 shooting while grabbing 15 rebounds. Senior guard **Scott Morton** (right) added 22 points to go over the 1,000-mark for his career while pulling down nine boards and making five steals. Geneseo is coming off a season in which it finished 19-8 and 11-5 in the State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC). In the SUNYAC playoffs, the Knights topped Cortland 63-60 in the first round before falling to eventual conference champion Plattsburgh 65-57 in the semifinals. Morton and Howe were Geneseo's top two scorers last season, averaging 16.0 and 14.3 points per game, respectively. Morton also led the team in assists (144) and blocks (39) and was third in rebounding (5.4 rpg). Howe was the team's leading rebounder, hauling in 6.5 boards per night, and blocked 21 shots while shooting 60.2% from the field. Junior forward **Brandon Simpson** also returns after scoring 6.6 points per night while starting 14 games a year ago.
