# Championship Preview

## **Bullets** #1 Gettysburg College Bullets (13-2, 7-1 CC)

Gettysburg opens tournament play under 21st-year head coach **Hank Janczyk** with the top-ranked defense in the conference, holding its opponents to 7.17 goals per game. Leading the charge on the defensive end of the field is defenseman **Andrew McGann**, a two-time all-American who was named to the preseason watch list for the Tewaaron Trophy, given to the top male and female collegiate lacrosse players. Since becoming the team's starting goalkeeper seven games into the season, junior **Zachary Furshman** has performed well, going 8-2 with a conference-leading 6.86 goals-against average. Offensively, the Bullets rank second in the Centennial with 12.60 goals per game. Sophomore attackman **Joe Brody** has enjoyed an outstanding season, leading the team in goals (41) and points (50).

In addition to Brody, Gettysburg has received offensive contributions from a number of players, including 2007 honorable mention all-Americans **Trip Dyer** and **Ben Sufrin**. Dyer, a senior attackman, and Sufrin, a senior midfielder, have added 24 goals apiece while combining for 21 assists.

Janczyk, who earlier this season became just the third NCAA lacrosse coach to reach 300 career wins, has coached Gettysburg to 11 Centennial Conference titles, including the last four.



## #2 Washington (Md.) College Shoremen (12-2, 7-1 CC)

The Shoremen enter the tournament as the second seed after a solid regular season. Washington's only two losses were against the top two teams in Division III – a 17-10 loss to No. 2 Gettysburg and a 15-11 setback at No. 1 Salisbury in its regular season finale.

Paced by senior attackman **Chris Read**, Washington boasts the top-ranked offense in the Centennial Conference, averaging 12.71 goals per game. Read has led the way with a conference-leading 45 goals and 67 points. Senior attackman **Kolyn Kirby** (35g, 25a) and junior attackman **Jimmy Kielek** (25g, 30a) complete the Shoremen's dangerous front line. Defensively, Washington ranks next to last in the conference in goals allowed (8.93 per game). Junior goalie **Gordon Cohen** has played nearly every minute in goal, posting an 8.97 GAA and a .647 save percentage.

Washington has made its mark in a major way on special teams, leading the conference in both man-up (45.5%) and man-down (82.0% penalty kill) situations.

The Shoremen have advanced to the championship game to face Gettysburg in all seven of the previous years that the Centennial Conference tournament has been held, going 1-6 over that stretch and winning its lone conference tournament title in 2003. The Shoremen also won Centennial Conference titles in 1996 and 1997.



## #3 Haverford College Fords (11-3, 6-2 CC)

After failing to reach the Centennial Conference playoffs from 2001-05, Haverford has qualified for the tournament for the third straight season. And just like Washington, the Fords suffered their only losses to nationally-ranked programs – falling 17-12 to No. 2 Gettysburg, 12-6 to No. 5 Washington, and 13-8 to No. 8 Cabrini.

Haverford has also established itself as an explosive offensive team and ranks third in the conference in goals per game (11.64). Leading the attack has been the dynamic duo of sophomore **Brian Fleishhacker** and freshman **Max Hjelm**. Fleishhacker has piled up 44 goals while Hjelm has registered 36 tallies a team-leading 18 assists. Senior midfielder **Dean Granoff** and senior attackman **Mike Distler** have added 20 goals each, with Distler also distributing 17 assists. Between the pipes, senior **Jake Mendlinger** has been the goalie of record in every game, logging an 8.34 goals-against average and a .576 save percentage.

The Fords are seeking their first-ever Centennial Conference playoff victory after losing to Gettysburg in the first round in each of the past two years.



## #4 Muhlenberg College Mules (10-4, 5-3 CC)

Muhlenberg, which earned its first-ever Centennial Conference playoff berth since the program was reinstated in 2003, enters this year's tournament as one of the hottest teams in the conference. The Mules reeled off eight straight wins to end the regular season, including a thrilling 9-8 victory over Ursinus in their regular season finale. Sophomore goalie **Andrew Bell** made tough save on a bounce shot with three seconds left against Ursinus to secure their play-off-clinching win.

The Mules were just 2-4 and 0-3 in conference play following their 14-9 loss at Haverford on March 26, but they won out the rest of the way. The streak was kicked off by a 15-5 thumping of Swarthmore, followed by a 9-8, triple-overtime nailbiter at Franklin & Marshall.

Senior midfielder **Kyle Farris** has led the team's offense this season, scoring 35 goals. Freshman attackman **Brent Siebold** and junior attackman **Andrew Lolley** have added 23 and 20 goals, respectively, while senior attackman **Mickey Norton** leads the Mules with 24 assists. Muhlenberg ranks second in the conference in man-up situations at 31.4%. Defensively, the Mules have posted the third-best goals-against mark in the conference at 7.81. **Bell**, the goalie of record in every game, ranks second in the Centennial with his 7.67 GAA and has posted a .561 save percentage.
